#### **5.1 Conclusions**

Based on the findings and discussion in the previous chapter, the researcher concluded that utilizing random text strategy is effective in teaching Reading at the secondyears students of SMP Negeri1 Lambu in academic years 2020/2021. It's clear from the students who were taught utilizing random text techniqque that is effective in teaching reading. The mean The experimental group's score was greater than the control group's. The Sig. (2-tailed) is 0,000 0.005, thus  $H_0$  is rejected while  $H_a$  is approved, according to the "paired sample test" output table above. As a result, it may be stated that there are disparities in the average between the pre-test and post-test learning outcomes. If the sig. (2-tailed) of the Independent Test is 0,0000,05, it means that employing random text strategy has a significant difference in students' results between students who are taught using random text strategy and those who are not. As a result, utilizing the random text technique as a strategy for teaching reading to second-year students has proven to be effective. accepted.

## 5.2 Suggestion

There are some suggestions to offer to the English teachers and the other researchers based on researcher findings.

1. Random text strategy is effective to improve students' Reading.
