CHAPTER V

CONCLUSIONS AND SUGGESTIONS

In this chapter, the writer presents the conclusions of overal view of what has been discussed in the previous chapters, and suggestions that hopefully be useful and give additional input in the teaching and learning English.

5.1 Conclusions

Based on the findings and discussions, the writer comes to the conclusion that there are two elements that are analyzed in this textbook, namely: forms of compound and the meaning of compound word.

1. Forms of Compound Word

There are 60 data of compound words that are found in the English texbook of "When English Rings a Bell" which are divided into three forms, they are Noun compound (43 or 71,6%), Adjective compound (11 or 18,3%) and Verb compound (6 or 10%) which 169 pages.

2. Meaning of Compound Word

Based on te data analysis, the writer found two forms of the meaning of compound word, they are transparent meaning and opaque meaning. There are (34 or 56,6%) which belong to transprent meaning and (26 or 43,3%) which belong to opaque meaning.

5.2 Suggestion

Reviewing the overall research that has been done, the writer proposes some suggestions, namely: It is expected that this compound words analysis becomes one of the reference in analyzing compound word on the other textbook, handbook etc, the teachers may can use this research as a reference in transferring knowledge to their students, especially about forms and meaning of compound words. The critics of morphology may also use compound as one of the alternative theories in reviewing or criticizing compound words and than for the next researchers who want to take English textbook entitled. When English Rings a Bell to analyze another compound, morphology and suggested for other researchers who are interested in conducting research focusing on compound word to find more other sources, it is essensial in order to make the upcoming researches better both theoritically and analitically.


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Appendix 2

AN ANALYSIS THE PERCENTAGE OF COMPOUND WORDS.

An analysis is done to determine the percentage of compound words.

1. Forms of compound

a. Noun Compound

Known: Frequencies = 43

Total = 60

Ask: % noun compound =?

Solution:

The equation used to calculate the percentages are as follows:

 $%Nound\ compound = \frac{Frequencies}{Total} x100\%$

 $%Noun\ compound = \frac{43}{60} \times 100\%$

 $\frac{\text{%Noun compound}}{60}$

 $%Noun\ compound = 71,6\%$

So, the percentage of noun compound is 71.6%.

b. Verb compound

Known: Frequencies = 6

Total = 60

Ask: % noun compound =?

Solution:

The equation used to calculate the percentages are as follows:

 $\%Nound\ compound = \frac{Frequencies}{Total} x100\%$ $\%Noun\ compound = \frac{6}{60} x100\%$ $\%Noun\ compound = \frac{600}{60} \%$

 $%Noun\ compound = 10\%$

So, the percentage of verb compound is 10%.

c. Adjective compound

Known: Frequencies = 11

Total = 60

Ask: % noun compound =?

Solution:

The equation used to calculate the percentages are as follows:

 $%Nound\ compound = \frac{Frequencies}{Total} x100\%$

 $\frac{11}{60} \times 100\%$

 $%Noun\ compound = \frac{1100}{60}\%$

 $%Noun\ compound = 18,3\%$

So, the percentage of adjective compound is 18.3%.

2. Meaning of Compound

a. Transparent meaning

Known: Frequencies

Total = 60

Ask: % transparent meaning =?

Solution:

The equation used to calculate the percentages are as follows:

 $\% transparent = \frac{Frequencies}{Total} x 100\%$ $\% transparent = \frac{34}{60} x 100\%$ $\% transparent = \frac{3400}{60} \%$

%transparent = 56,6%

So, the percentage of transparent mening is 56,6%

b. Opaque meaning

Known: Frequencies = 26

Total = 60

Ask: % opaque meaning =?

Solution:

The equation used to calculate the percentages are as follows:

$$\%opaque = \frac{Frequencies}{Total} x100\%$$

$$\%opaque = \frac{26}{60} x100\%$$

$$\%opaque = \frac{2600}{60} \%$$

$$\%opaque = 43,3\%$$

So, the percentage of opaque meaning is 43.3%
