### **CHAPTER V**

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This chapter consisted of the conclusion and suggestion related to the students' ability in pronunciation skills in the fourth semester of the English department Faculty of Teacher Training and Education of Muhammadiah Unoversity of Mataram

## 5.1 Conclusion

From the finding of the study, the researcher concluded that some students' abilities connected to pronunciation skills needed to improve based on the data discovered and discussed in the preceding chapter. Students continue to pronounce words incorrectly. Furthermore, the minority participants (three participants), from the results of the percentage score, are still below 65 percent or are wrong in pronouncing more than 10 words. While four, four participants are above 60%. The data indicate that pronunciation teaching and learning needs huge consideration. In addition, a means of the average score determination is concluded based on the results of the entire student text. In addition, a means of the average score determination is concluded based on the results of the entire student text; it is determined based on the rubrics scoring (see Table 3.4.1). After adding up these results, the researcher divided the total score by the total participants and the results became the participants' average score. After carrying out these steps, the average ability of the participants was 63 percent; this figure shows the ability of students in the *average* category and must be improved.

The researcher's terms were nonetheless difficult for some learners to pronounce. This was a result of their limited pronunciation expertise, and it showed that students needed to improve their capacity to acquire pronunciation to resolve the problems. Students struggled to discern words that sound similar in reading and writing as a result of this issue. At the same time, The data is consistent with the findings of the interviews which lead to students still experiencing difficulties in developing their pronunciation skills. Despite the weakness of student, leaning pronunciation in the previous semester have improved students' pronunciation skill. However, the scope of this study was still somewhat small, further research was still needed to fully understand the data that has been given.

# 5.2 **Suggestion**

Based on the conclusion above, the researcher proposed some suggestions:

## 5.2.1 For the teacher

Understand the students more to know what the students need and to develop the proper subject matter and teaching method.

## 5.2.2 For the students

The students should actively participate in the educational process, and not be timid or scared to talk in English, especially when pronouncing words. To enhance their pronunciation while studying, they should feel comfortable speaking English to their teacher or a friend.

# 5.2.3 For the next researcher

It is proposed that future researchers might use this study as a model for subsequent studies in the same area. Future researchers may employ other study techniques to learn more about students' pronunciation skills as well as other skills like writing, reading, and listening. The employment of text-to-speech software in writing different genres may then be the subject of future research to determine its impact.


